Chronophobia is a specific psychological phobia which manifests itself as a persistent, abnormal and unwarranted fear of time or of the passing of time. A related but much rarer phobia is chronomentrophobia , the irrational fear of clocks and watches.

Chronophobia is defined as the persistent and often irrational fear of the future or the fear of passing time. Since time can be considered as a "specific object", Chronophobia falls under the category of specific phobias. The word Chronophobia is derived from Greek 'chronos' meaning time

and phobos meaning fear.

Simply stated, Chronophobia is the morbid and irrational fear of time. For the most part, time is not necessarily a feared object or concept on its own, but rather that it may be moving too fast, or that the individual is unable to comprehend it.
