A bailey, also called a ward, was a fortified enclosure. It was a common feature of castles, and most had at least one. The keep on top of the motte was the domicile of the lord in charge of the castle and a bastion of last defence, while the bailey was the home of the rest of the lord's household and gave them protection.

Castle Features Although castle design varied widely throughout Europe, there were some similar features that many castles incorporated: Moat - A moat was a defensive ditch dug around the castle. It could be filled with water and there was typically a drawbridge across it to get to the castle gate.

Little now remains of Aberedw Castle above ground although, as at most castle sites, probably some 10 feet of masonry is still buried in its own ruins. Apart from the modern north to south running track that bisects the castle, entrance is currently gained via a low causeway crossing the ditch to the site of the east curtain.
