### **What is the Antikythera Mechanism?**

The Antikythera mechanism (/ , æ n t i k i ' θ i ə r ə / , / , æ n t i ' k i θ ə r ə /) is an ancient Greek analogue computer used to predict astronomical positions and eclipses for calendar and astrological purposes decades in advance. It could also be used to track the four-year cycle of athletic games which was similar to an Olympiad, the cycle of the ancient Olympic Games.
