The paper won a Nobel Prize in Economic Sciences in 1991.

But today we're actually not writing about the "nature" of the firm in the Coasean sense at all. Rather, I want to open a discussion into "What are firms for?," or what is the nature of firms' obligations to their owners, employees, clients, competitors, markets, and communities. Let's begin in the middle, as it were.

Coase says that the creation of the firm can reduce these friction by bringing people "under one tent" and removing the need for individuals to trade with each other in the free market. Instead, individuals provide their services to other individuals inside the firm according to the firm's organizational structure.

increasing marginal costs of organizing more transactions within the firm. decreasing returns of managerial ability (knowledge, computation limits..) So the scope of the firm is determined at the margin. MC of organizing one more transaction within the firm equals the cost of using alternative institutional arrangements.
